Heavily scented, well branched plants with a long flowering period.

- A good product for 1 litre pot production in spring into summer.
- Ideal for borders or containers and attractive to bees and other insects.
- Half-hardy perennial.

Sowing:

- Sow on a moist seed sowing compost in a 286 plug tray or similar size cell.
- Cover lightly with vermiculite and propagate at 18-20° C.
- Germination should begin to take place after 10-14 days.
- Maintain a temperature of 15° C after germination.

Growing:

- When the seedlings are established cool them down slightly to 10° C and transfer them to a 6 pack or 9 cm container for final sale.
- January sowing should result in saleable plants late April.
- Later sowings can be made in late March-April for later pot bedding sale.
