

ASARINA SCANDENS CLIMING MIX

SOWING INSTRUCTIONS:

Depth: Surface sow and press in lightly.

Sprout Time: 10-20 days

Starting Indoors: Sow indoors 10-12 weeks before planting out after frost. Keep at 65-70°F.

Starting Outdoors: Direct sow in warmer climates (zones 8+) after soil has warmed in springtime.

When to Set Outside: After last frost.

PLACEMENT & CULTIVATION

Asarina is a native of Mexico and an unbeatable choice for trellised pots on the patio, producing scads of pouty lipped violet-blue trumpets on wiry stems all season long. This robust twining vine is easy-care too, for it sheds the spent flowers, no deadheading needed.

Final Spacing: 1'

Water Use: Medium Water Use

Watering Details: Keep evenly moist—at least 1" of water per week, more during particularly dry and hot spells, but avoid saturated soils.

Soil pH: Not particular about pH

Fertilizer: Mix in an inch of compost or an organic balanced fertilizer when planting and continue monthly applications.

Diseases & Pests: No major problems.

When to Cut: Not a good cut flower.
