

CLEOME QUEEN SERIES

Here is a germination method to help with germination of Cleome Queen series.

1-Sow and cover seeds with coarse vermiculite to keep humidity.

2-Light helps the cleome to germinate, so be sure that the seedlings are in the right location to get light.

3 - Cleome requires higher than normal temperatures to germinate. He also likes the temperature differences between day and night. (up to 10 degrees F between day and night):
Day temperature between 26 and 30 C (80 - 85F)
Night temperature between 20-21 C (68-70 F)

4 - Fertilizers containing potassium nitrate (KNO₃) helps to break dormancy of seeds.

5 - Germination is slow and can take up to 28 days.

Note: Soak seeds 24 hours before sowing can also help.
