Chrysanthemum paludosum



COLORS AVAILABLE: Limelight, Magma, Marble, Palisandra, Rustic Red, Formula Mixture

FLOWER/GARDEN SIZE: Height: 20 inches, width: 10 – 14 inches; annual

NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Extra-large leaves, adds texture and color to garden, thrives in partial sun and shade

MARKET USE: Patio, garden, house plant

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

CONTAINER SIZE:

SOWING: 288 plug tray

FINISH CONTAINER: Packs, 4 - 6" pots, gallon

PLUG STAGE:

GERMINATION: Emergence 8-10 days / 70-75°F; cover seed lightly

EC (POUR THRU METHOD): 0.4 mS/cm - 0.6 mS/cm

Coleus is sensitive to high salt, particularly ammonium

PLUG FINISH TIME: 4 - 5 weeks from sow

FINISHING:

WEEKS TO FINISH: 7-10 from sow

MOISTURE: Moderate

TEMPERATURE: 65-85°F day / 65 - 72°F night — provide light shade to cool leaf temperature under high

light and heat

EC: 0.75 mS/cm (pour thru method)

pH: 5.8—6.0

COMMON DISEASES/PESTS Downy mildew, powdery mildew/Aphid, whitefly, mealy bug

NOTES:

• Paclobutrazol, daminozide, and chlormequat PGRs are all effective
