

Juncus effusus 'Spiralis'

SIZE/PLANT HABIT/TYPE: Hardy perennial, to USDA zone 4
Height: 2 feet

NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Strong, twisted, upright leaves

MARKET USE: Very effective in the landscape, young plants work in pots and mixed containers

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

CONTAINER SIZE:

SOWING: 3 seeds per 288 tray, lightly fertilized peat

PLUG STAGE:

GERMINATION Emergence 35-45 days / 72-75 °F / Leave seed uncovered

FINISHING:

TRANSPLANT: 8 – 9 weeks after sowing to well-drained, evenly moist soil

WEEKS TO FINISH: 22 – 26 depending on conditions (warmth and light decrease finish time)

TEMPERATURE: 60 – 75°F day / 60 – 65°F night

EC: 1.2 – 1.5 mS/cm (pour thru method)

PH: 5.5 – 6.2

NOTES:

Regular feeding with a balanced fertilizer is beneficial.

Plants sown in winter grow slowly when young and grow faster in late spring and early summer when there is more light and warmth
