Transplant: 20-30 days Days to Flower: 8 to 10 weeks Ideal Temperature: day 60-70°F / night 55-60°F

Garden:

Sunny location Height: 12 to 15 inches Width: 30 to 36 inches

Notes:

Short internodes, flowers in center of plant out to edges with an abundance of blooms and no bare spots, excellent after rain recovery. *Rates suggested as a starting point. Growers should adjust rates according to their own growing conditions.
