Petunia hybrid

Name: Petunia F1 Trilogy Purple

Novelty Characteristics:

Novel dome shape with some spread, maintains tidy habit, good day length neutrality, high flower count covers plant, bred with benefits for grower, retailer, and consumer

Market Use:

Hanging baskets, mixed containers, excellent garden and landscape performance

Recommended Growing/Selling Form:

packs, 4" pots, 6" pots, hanging baskets, large containers

Flower:

Blooms continuously all season

Colors Available:

Blue, Deep Purple, Lavender Blush, Rose, Salmon, Salmon Morn, Scarlet, White, Red (AAS 2015)

Germination Conditions:

4-7 days / 72-76°F / leave seed uncovered
*soil must be near saturation for good germination, once emergence has occurred lower both temperature (65-68°F) and moisture content

Growing:

Transplant: 20-30 days
Days to Flower: 8 to 10 weeks
Ideal Temperature: day 60-70°F / night 55-60°F

Garden:

Sunny location
Height: 12 to 15 inches
Width: 30 to 36 inches

Notes:

Short internodes, flowers in center of plant out to edges with an abundance of blooms and no bare spots, excellent after rain recovery.

*Rates suggested as a starting point. Growers should adjust rates according to their own growing conditions.
