

Zinnia Sunshine Mix

Zinnia elegans



COLORS AVAILABLE: Cherry, Gold, Red, Sunshine Mix

SIZE/PLANT HABIT: Height: 30 - 36" indoors, 24 - 30" field / Branching / Annual

NOVELTY CHARACTERISTICS: Extra-early flowering, excellent uniformity, double flowered blooms

MARKET USE: Cut flower, tall bedding

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

SEASONAL APPLICATIONS:

SOWING: Spring, early summer

FINISHING:: Summer to fall

PHOTOPERIODISM: Not daylength sensitive

PLUG STAGE:

TRAY SIZE: 288, 200, avoid stress to prevent premature flower initiation

GERMINATION: Emergence 5 - 7days / 70 °F / cover with vermiculite

PLUG FINISH: 3 weeks

FINISHING:

TRANSPLANT: 14 – 20 days after sowing

SPACING: 8" x 8" in greenhouse, 8" x 12" in field

DAYS TO FLOWER AFTER

SOWING: 50– 65 days

TEMPERATURE: 60 - 65°F

COMMON DISEASE/PEST: Botrytis, powdery mildew / Aphids, thrips, leafrollers

NOTES:

- Requires full sun to bloom
- The center flower can be pinched off so that the other blooms flower evenly
- The closer spaced the plants are the taller they become but the incidence of mildew problems increases. Try to prevent mildew problems with good air movement when controllable or apply regular fungicide applications.
