### **Plant Details:**

**Scientific Name:** Gaillardia

**Common Name:** Blanket Flower

**Hardiness Zone:** 3a - 9b

**Hardiness Degree:** -40°F (-40.0°C)

**Blooming Season:** Summer, Late Summer, Autumn

**Characteristics:** Attracts Butterflies, Heat Tolerant

**General Information:** Adds dazzling color to perennial or butterfly gardens. Low, compact variety is ideal at garden's edge. Beautiful planted with coreopsis, yarrow, or perennial salvia. Trim attractive seed heads periodically to make room for new flowers.

**Grower Information:**

The 4-in. (10-cm) flowers have bright red petals tipped with golden yellow, red centers. Small, gray-green leaves.
