Sowing/Growing information	
Sowing	Sow from May to July for flowering plants in May the following year. Using a 286 plugs tray or slightly larger sized unit, sow on to the surface of a moist well-drained seed sowing compost lightly cover the seed with vermiculite and propagate at 18 °C. Temperatures higher than 25 °C will reduce the rate of germination considerably. Germination should take place after 2 weeks.
Growing	Grow on the seedlings in a lightly shaded area until they are established and fill the tray. Pot on in late August - September into 1 litre pot or put 3 plugs into 2 or 3 litre pots. Over winter in a well-ventilated unheated glasshouse or tunnel for sales the following March / April or for flowering plants ready to sell in early May to June.
