

Garden huckleberry – Vaccinium / Important: Not to be confused with the true blueberry.

Do not eat raw, the taste is bitter. For optimal appreciation must be cooked.

Taste Fresh: like green tomato.

Aspect Round, violet-black, fruit similar to blueberries, but 2 to 3 times bigger.

Sowing Sow seeds indoors under lights, approximately 6 to 8 weeks before the expected date of the last ground frost in your area. Harden the seedlings before planting in the garden.

Plant Requires an even moisture. Be careful however not to over-water, as this will reduce their flavour. Grow in a warm and sunny area.

Harvest When berries turn very black, it is time to harvest. Should be cooked before eating.
