Tolerance (T)

Ability of a plant variety to endure abiotic stress pressure without severe consequences of its growth, development, appearance and yield.

High resistance (HR)

Ability of a plant to highly restrict the growth and/or development of a specified pest and/or the damage it causes under normal pest pressure when compared to susceptible varieties. These plant varieties may, however, exhibit some symptoms or damage under heavy pest pressure.

Intermediate resistance (IR)

Ability of a plant to restrict the growth and/or development of a specified pest and/or the damage it causes but may exhibit a greater range of symptoms or damage compared to high resistant varieties. Plants with Intermediate Resistance will still show less severe symptoms or damage than susceptible plant varieties when grown under similar environmental conditions and/or pest pressure.

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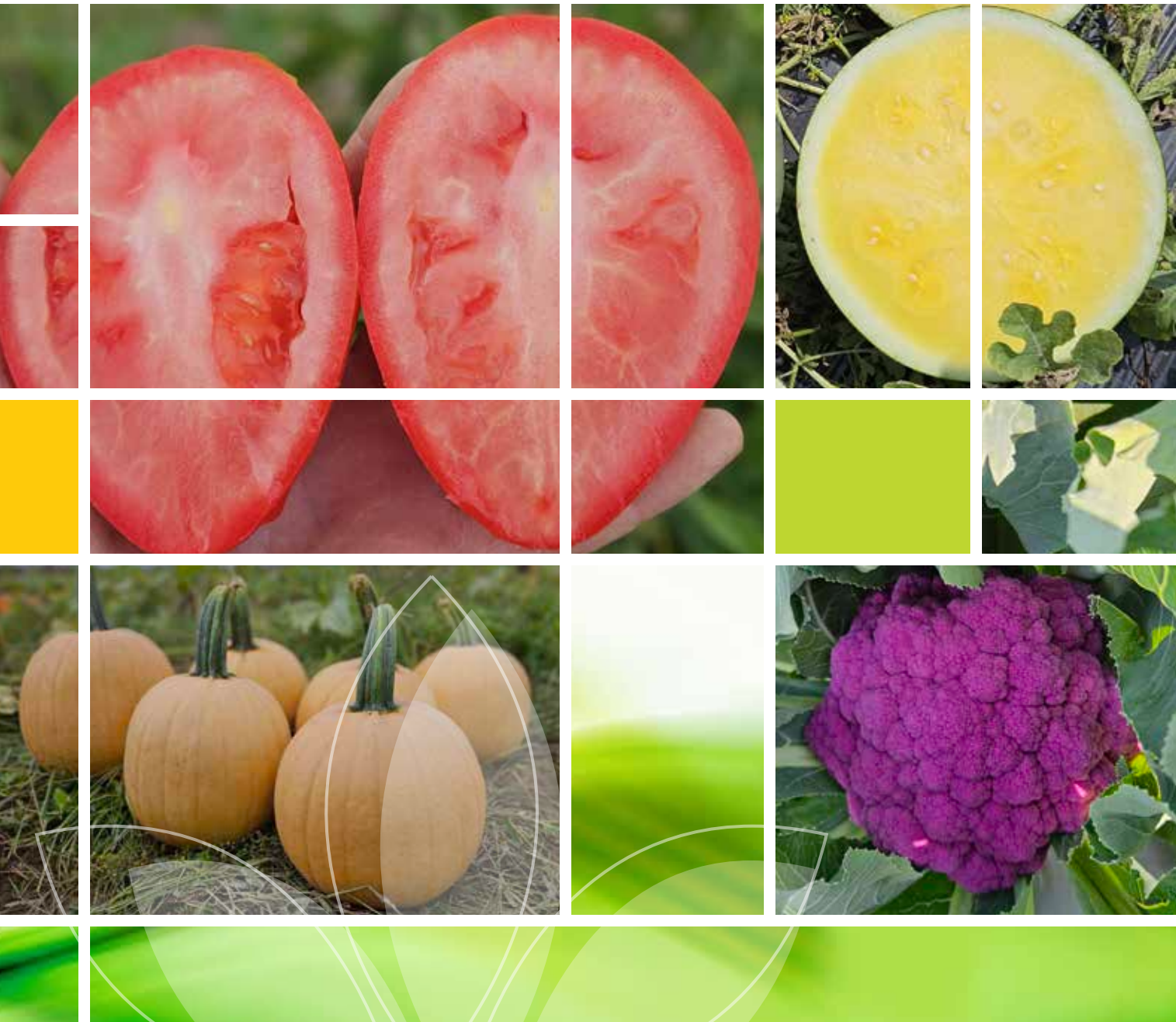
