## SWEET CORN



### 65-1166-UNT Sweet Corn Rosie F1 Bicolour Sh2

Beautifully refined ear and kernels. Superior eating quality. High sugar content. Attractive, with large size ears. Excellent field holding ability. Strong plant.

**Untreated seeds.**

**Maturity :** 74 days  
**Number of rows :** 16-18  
**Cob length :** 20 cm  
**Cob height :** 70 cm  
**Plant height :** 180 cm

## BROCCOLI



### 65-1496-UNT Broccoli Mini Sibsey F1

Dark green, stem broccoli. Starts out similar to a regular crown broccoli but after harvesting the first crown, easy-to-harvest tender and tasty side shoots continue to appear long into the season. Tolerant to warm temperature bolting. Replaces the Apollo variety.

**Untreated seeds.**

**Maturity :** 85 days  
**Harvest season :**  
Spring, Summer, Fall

## SQUASH



### 65-4602-ORG Winter Squash Cha-Cha F1 (Kabocha)

Standard Kabocha bred for flavour and storage. Beautiful bright orange flesh that cooks up flaky, sweet, and delicious. Resists rotting in storage longer than most standard green Kabochas.

**Organic seeds.**

**Maturity :** 95 days  
**Colour :** Dark green  
**Fruit shape :**  
Round-flat

## LETTUCE



### 65-5639-OPC Oakleaf Lettuce Bauer

Uniform, compact oak leaf lettuce with a darker colour than other varieties in the same category. Can be grown almost anywhere, in-ground, containers, or window boxes and harvested at the baby leaf stage or grown full-sized head. Dense heads that produce an abundance of sweet, crisp sturdy leaves. Replaces the Panisse variety.

**Organic and coated seeds.**

**Maturity :** 55 days  
**Colour :** Green  
**Tolerances :** Downy Mildew (Bremia) races: 1-9 - Lettuce Leaf Aphid - Lettuce Mosaic Virus

## RADISH



### 65-8062-UNT Radish Purpella F1

Stunning dark purple hybrid radishes with better uniformity and adaptability than most OP selections. Very fast to size up, Purpella holds well in the field, with a crispy, bright white interior even when other purple varieties have become pithy.

**Untreated seeds.**

**Maturity :** 27 days

**Use :** Bunching, cello

## TOMATO



### 65-8881-UNT Tomato Pink Delicious F1 Pink

Early maturing tomatoes that have an heirloom look, flavour and texture with hybrid disease resistance and improved germination, meaning it is much easier to grow. Earlier with a higher yield than most pink tomatoes and a very uniform fruit size. Big fruits do not crack as much. Excellent flavour and high Brix for a sweeter taste than normal pink tomatoes.

**Untreated seeds.**

**Maturity :** 75 days

### 65-9003-UNT Tomato Darkstar F1 Purple

High yield of purple, oblate and ribbed fruits, with the looks and taste of an heirloom tomato and the added bonus of late blight tolerance.

### 65-9313-UNT Grape Tomato Sun Dipper F1 Orange

Surprising orange "dipper" tomato with elongated fruit that is easily held between your fingers for dipping in dressing. Very sweet, rich flavour with an acidic finish. Crack tolerant. Performs well in field production as well as high tunnels.

## HERBS



### 67-1121-UNT Sweet Basil Devotion DMR (Genovese)

An aromatic and sweet Genovese-type basil with excellent downy mildew resistance. Flat to cup-shaped leaves that are tender, flavourful and productive throughout the growing season. Slow to bolt. Extremely uniform.

**Annual. Untreated seeds.**



### 67-1131-UNT Basil Everleaf Thai Towers

Columnar basil that has green leaves with occasional purple flecks and soft purple stems. Aromatic and vibrant licorice flavour. Late bloomer that allows for large quantities of flavourful leaves to be harvested throughout the summer.

**Annual. Untreated seeds.**

## STRAWBERRY



### 66-3803-UNT Greenhouse Strawberry Soraya F1

Specifically bred for both summer and winter production with "particularly strong performance" under LED lights, but also very well suited for a year-round production. Firm and bright fruit ideal for retail. The flavourful strawberries in all seasons.

## CUCUMBER



### 66-4232-UNT Greenhouse Cucumber Splash (DRCB60258) F1 Mini

Crunchy and dense fruits with a good shelf life that grow on strong, vigorous plants that require less labour than comparable. For high wire or umbrella cultivation.

**Tolérance :** Cucumber Green Mottle Mosaic Virus - Powdery Mildew  
**Production season :** All year round

## TOMATO



### 66-9075-GEU Greenhouse Tomato/TOV Prodice F1 Red

Large jointless, truss tomato with exceptional interior and exterior red colour. Good average degrees Brix content. High yield potential. Suitable for year-round crops.

**Untreated and primed seeds.**

**Tolerances :** Tomato Mosaic Virus (ToMV) - Fusarium Wilt (2 races) - Powdery Mildew - Verticillium Wilt - Torrado Tomato Virus (ToTV) - Grey Leaf Spot (Stemphyllium)

### 66-9091-GEU Greenhouse Tomato/TOV Albrice (DR1035) F1 Red

Coarse bunch variety with good earliness, intense red fruit colour both internally and externally and high Brix potential. Rapid coloration of the jointless fruits. Vigorous plant. Excellent flavour. Suitable for year-round production.

**Untreated and primed seeds.**
